



## **How to start a podcast**

### **Step 1:**

Develop a podcast concept

Before starting ask yourself some questions:

“What is my podcast about?”, “Why am I starting a podcast?”

### **Step 2**

Identify your goals

- What for am I doing it?
- What is the purpose/ the main topic of my podcast?
- Do I have to check any essential vocabulary, do any research before?
- Do I want to share any ideas? Which ones?
- Will I ask my listeners to do any follow-up exercises afterwards?  
How am I going to organize it?

### **Step 3:**

Podcast recording equipment and software

You can start recording a podcast with just your iPhone and a pair of headphones. Remember, your content is the most crucial part.



Once you've recorded your podcast, it's time to make edits and adjustments to achieve the best sound quality possible.

Podcast editing software is affordable, e.g. audacity. It is a free and open-source audio editor. Open source editors allow users to make changes to the original code easily.

Furthermore, Zoom has become one of the go-to online interview platforms for podcasting. It will allow you to save each speaker's audio to separate tracks.

#### **Step 4:**

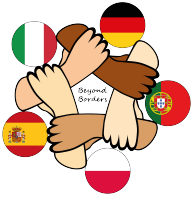
If we record the podcast for some educational purposes it is a good idea to use it in terms for example of the content, vocabulary, phrases, useful collocations.

So, after listening you can ask your listeners to prepare a set of exercises concerning the content of your podcast or you can do it on your own and check if your podcast was understood.

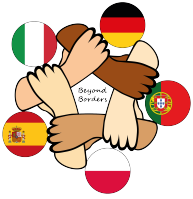
